New entry regulations for the British Virgin Islands 2025

New entry regulations have been in place for the British Virgin Islands since the beginning of the year. Before travellers depart for the overseas territory in the Caribbean, they must complete an entry and customs form at home and submit it online. The subsequent confirmation must either be printed out or presented in digital form on a smartphone or tablet upon arrival. The form is available 72 hours before arrival, with the exception of cruise ship passengers. Link to the Federal Foreign Office.
